Directions: You will be assigned a map station. At the map station you will examine the map in detail and complete answers to the following questions. Consider the five themes of geography in your answers: location, place, human/ environment interaction, movement, and regions. After you have finished your questionnaire, you are expected to *verbally* share your responses with your map station group members. Then summarize and record your ideas as a team on the blank overhead to present your ideas to the class.

1. What type of map is at your station?

(Ex. This is a population map.)

2. What are five items that you observe from the map?

(Ex. I observe that Pakistan's capital is Islamabad.)

3. Using three different ways, describe the location of Pakistan on your map.

(Ex. Pakistan is located north of the Arabian Sea in the region of South Asia.)

4. What are three features or landforms that you think will impact life in Pakistan and **how**?

(Ex. I think the Arabian Sea will impact life in Pakistan by providing port cities for shipping and industry to move products and supplies.)

5. What are two things you learned about Pakistan by studying your map that you *did not know* before?

(Ex. I did not know that Pakistan's Punjabi ethnic group is also present in India.)

6. One thing I have a question about from this map is...

(Ex. One question I have from examining this map is *why* is there a dotted line near the Northern Territory region rather than a solid line?)
